**DRUMLINE:** Practices are Thursdays & Fridays from 3:10 to 4:30p.m.

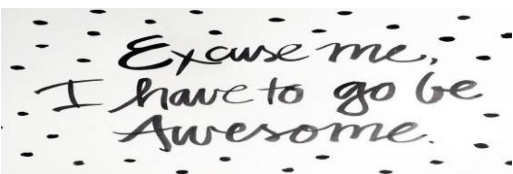
