
Mr. Richins took his 8<sup>th</sup> grade Honor's Class to the Pima Air and Space Museum. The kids had a blast!

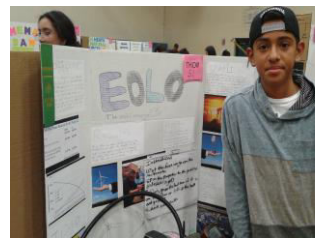
